Our approach

The range of funding opportunities available in the Framework Programme is broad, and the time required putting together strong consortia and writing winning proposals means being aware of the upcoming calls and topics as early as possible is crucial; and provides organisations with an advantage in the increasingly competitive research funding landscape. Having early access to the latest information is therefore essential to support a strategy of realising research funding from the EU.

Research managers and principal investigators need to focus on their research fields, and few have the time to devote to navigating the vast range of funding opportunities to find the calls of interest to them. What they need is tailored information based on their specific areas of interest minimizing the provision of information which is of no interest to them and enabling them to capitalize on calls of direct interest to them.
